Through this training, you will develop the knowledge and skills to:

- Understand root causes of substance misuse
- Complete a needs assessment of community health problems and identify avenues for change
- Assess and build community capacity
- Choose, plan and implement effective prevention interventions
- Monitor and evaluate interventions for effectiveness, sustainability, and cultural competence

Prerequisites	Prior to the in-person training, participants must complete a self-paced, online course, " Introduction to Substance Abuse Prevention: Understanding the Basics " to gain background knowledge on the field of prevention.
Date and Location	The four-day SAPST training will be held at the Northwest HIDTA offices in downtown Seattle from October 22 -25, 2024.
Continuing Education	Participants will receive two certificates of completion for the online course and in-person training for a total of 31 hours of continuing education.
