



Synthetic Opioid Awareness **8HRS**

This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers and other first responders an overview of the characteristics and hazards of fentanyl and the other novel synthetic opioids that have been found in the illicit drug supply. Students will learn current tactics, techniques, and procedures to mitigate hazards to first responders when fentanyl or other harmful synthetic opioids are present at the scene. This course provides training on the proper use and wear of personal protective equipment, including PPE donning and doffing, decontamination, and the basic first aid measures to help prevent and mitigate incidental exposure to synthetic opioids.
