COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on targeting criminal organizations, groups, or gangs that use legitimate commercial transportation to smuggle illegal drugs, bulk currency, weapons, and people across the U.S. It covers investigative techniques for detecting and disrupting these activities at transportation hubs, hotels/motels, self-storage facilities, and rental vehicle companies.

The course also highlights the importance of establishing and maintaining liaison with civilian counterparts. It also provides specific strategies for investigating self-storage businesses, including identifying dangerous materials that could be linked to terrorism or other public safety threats.
